Keizer and Salem both changed their yard debris program to "mixed organics" in 2010. What does that mean? It means you can add these items to your green cart:

- **ALL FOOD:** Including egg shells, meats & bones, bread, grains, coffee grounds, tea leaves, dairy products, fruits, vegetables. Even your Halloween pumpkins!
- SOME PAPER: Coffee filters, tea bags, napkins, paper towels, corrugated pizza boxes.
- **PLANTS:** Grass clippings, yard pruning's, leaves, pine needles, weeds, flowers & floral trimmings.
- NO: Paper plates, cups, "take-out" containers from restaurants, plastic bags, animal waste, foil, grease/oils, metal, personal hygiene products, styrofoam, plastic utensils.





LOREN'S EARNS MARION COUNTY EARTHWISE CERTIFICATION

EarthWISE Certification is a program operated by Marion County Environmental Services to recognize businesses in Marion County that have made a commitment to environmentally friendly practices. Businesses that immediately or over time meet pre-established criteria in the EarthWISE focus areas can earn EarthWISE Certification.

Loren's Sanitation became EarthWISE Certified in 2012. Some of our company's every day "green" practices include: a recycle box at every desk in the office; buying only recycled computer and copy paper; offering EFT and online payments to our customers as well as paperless billing; and using entirely third-party approved cleaning products, paper towels and toilet paper. Additionally the company's garbage and recycling trucks use 5% biodiesel fuel. There is a recycle depot behind the office building at 1141 Chemawa Rd N open to the public 24/7. Loren's believes in "practicing what we preach" so we are proud to be an EarthWISE certified company.

So, what to do with your plastic bags and film plastic? Most major grocery stores will accept them or they can be taken to the Salem Keizer Transfer Station (503-588-5169) on Deer Park Lane. Styrofoam can be recycled at the Fresh Start Market, 3020 Center St. NE.

DISPOSE OF UNWANTED MEDICATIONS IN POLICE DEPARTMENT LOBBY

A drug turn-in receptacle is available in the lobby of the Keizer Police Department, 930 Chemawa Rd N. Funding from Keizer Rotary and Community Action Drug Prevention Network makes it possible for the public to safely dispose of unwanted prescription and over-the-counter medications Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. There is no charge for this service.

Improperly disposed of medications are a risk to health, security and the environment. They can be scavenged from the garbage and abused; when they are flushed they are not removed by sewage treatment facilities and septic tank systems, so they can enter the soil, surface water and groundwater.

ACCEPTED MEDICATIONS: Prescription medications, Over-the-counter medications, and Veterinary medications.
